The Rehabilitation Assistant is an integral member of the Menno Place team and is required to have a commitment to the vision, mission and values of Menno Place performing duties following Menno Place policies and procedures and ensuring safety for residents and staff.

In keeping with Menno Place's Mission, Vision and Value statement, the Rehabilitation Assistant is one of Team Leader.

The Rehabilitation Assistant is responsible to implement rehabilitative treatment plans and programs, and assists the Therapist Manager under the direction of a therapist. These duties include (among others):

- 1. Carries out designated components of a rehabilitative treatment plans and/or program, such as activities of daily living, mobility, strengthening and balance exercises, recreation, and /or communication therapy.
- 2. Observes and reports, to the therapist, cognitive and functional changes in resident ability or behaviour that may warrant a progression or regression of the treatment documentation in the health record as directed by Therapist.
- 3. As part of a multidisciplinary team and in consultation with the therapist, provides input into the planning, implementation, modification, and evaluation of the rehabilitative treatment plan/program.
- 4. Transfers and positions patients in accordance with established transfer procedures, utilizing mechanical aids such as wheelchairs and lifts to ensure maximum comfort.
- 5. Provides functional skills training to residents and families in activities of daily living, mobility, and communication as directed by therapist; demonstrates the use of assistive devises. Assists with power and manual wheelchair mobility training.

Successful applicant must have:

• Completion of a Rehabilitation Assistant Program or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.

Required: Criminal Record Check, TB screen and influenza immunization.
